Planning Committee contingency arrangements

6th January 2022

In consideration of the continuing public health situation, Chobham Parish Council's Planning Committee has used its existing powers to reduce the number of in-person meetings it needs to hold, while ensuring members of the public continue to be represented in the planning process.

Planning decisions have temporarily been delegated to an officer of the Council, in consultation with Councillors. This arrangement will next be reviewed on 22nd February 2022.

The following Planning Committee meetings will be replaced by virtual planning meetings hosted by the relevant officer of the Council, which will be used to help inform decisions on planning applications and other planning business:

- Tuesday 11th January 2022 7:30 pm
- Tuesday 1st February 2022 7:30 pm
- Tuesday 22nd February 2021 7:30 pm

These meetings will be held by Zoom video conferencing, with agendas and minutes posted on the website under a separate "Planning Meetings" section. Arrangements for the public will be on the respective agendas, which will be posted no later than the Thursday before each meeting.

Meetings held under this delegation arrangement are not Committee meetings, and are unaffected by the 7th May 2021 expiry of the Coronavirus Act 2020 regulations which withdrew local Councils' powers to hold remote Council and Committee meetings.
