

Comments on Chobham Neighbourhood Plan 2019 – 2038

P.48 Photo of the bridge over the Bourne in Philpot Lane. This is known locally as Emmetts Mill Bridge.

P.51 6.8 Farmers Market. Chobham has a weekly market, the Chobham Country Market (formerly the W.I. Market) has been running for nearly 50 years.

P.60 Chobham Place Woods is part of Chobham Common, being Exchange Land for the Tank Factory most recently known as D.E.R.A. It was given SANG designation despite it already being public access land under Sec. 193 of LOP 1925.

P.80 8.10 D The Cycle Path between Chobham and Woking should also serve equestrians, the route runs mostly over Sec.193 land namely Milford Green and Coxhill Green.

P.138 8 View over Fair Oaks. Two Public Rights of Way mark the boundary of the Licensed Airfield, Bonseys Lane Footpath No.1. to the East and Youngstroat Lane Bridleway No.3 to the West. If the land was "criss-crossed" with paths, aviation activity would be difficult if not impossible!
